Lawn & Landscape Tip of the Month: *Spring Fertilizer Selection*

This goes hand in hand with last month's soil testing tip. It's time for that first Spring fertilizer application and it is imperative to choose the correct blend. Your local extension service can make a detailed recommendation on your specific lawn needs. Many of your local farm supply stores can actually blend specific fertilizers to your liking. If you are not looking to spend a large amount of time, look for a good starter fertilizer that will give your lawn the quick jump in color and vigor. A starter along the lines of a 10-10-10 is an old standby and its hard to go wrong with that combo. Try to put the application out just in advance of rain as it's crucial your fertilizer get watered in.

Did You Know?

Looking to provide a service to golf by hosting a tournament Bobby Jones and Clifford Roberts decided to hold an annual event beginning in 1934. Roberts proposed the event be called the Masters Tournament, but Bobby Jones objected thinking it too presumptuous. The name Augusta National Invitation Tournament was adopted and the title was used for five years until 1939 when Jones relented and the name was officially changed. An early decision was whether Jones would play or serve as an official. Jones preferred not to compete but was persuaded by the Club's members to join the field. In the 12 tournaments that Jones played, his best finish was 13th in 1934.
