February 6th - Superbowl Party

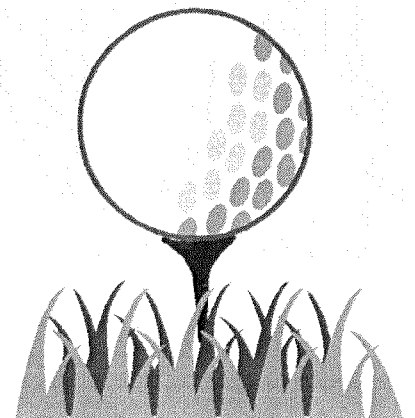
February 12th - Valentine's Dinner

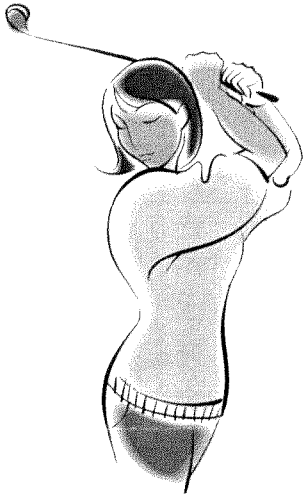
Thanks to all who helped make the Family Night with Santa a success. I think the kids had a great time and we had over 60 to attend!

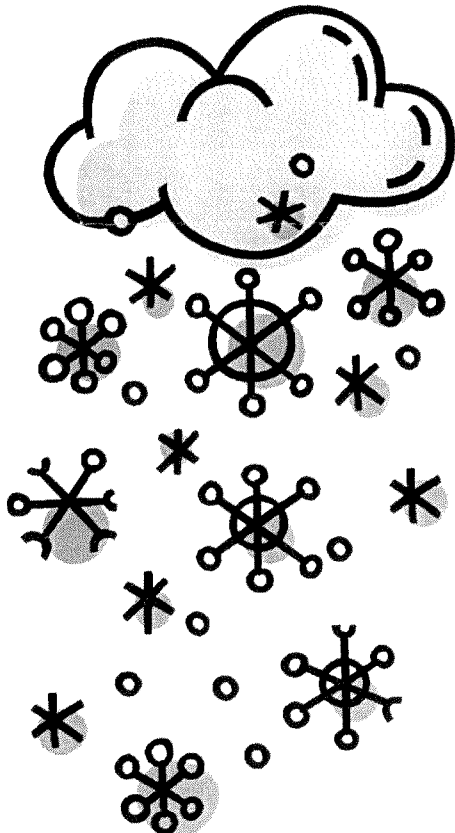
